This program has space for a maximum of 25 teens. Permission slips will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. All successfully registered participants will be contacted by Coli Creach in afternoon on **Thursday, February 7, 2019** to confirm their spot in the program.

I give permission for my teen to attend the NERF Battle at the Camdenton Library on **Friday, February 8, 2019** from **6:15 p.m. to 9:15 p.m.** I understand that my teen will **NOT** be able to exit and re-enter the program, that latecomers will **NOT** be admitted, and that I **MUST** pick up my teen from the Library **PROMPTLY** at **9:15 p.m.**

While noise level rules will be more relaxed, standard rules of conduct still apply. I understand that if my teen is not behaving in a manner compliant with the Library's Rules of Conduct (see the back side of this page), I may be contacted **PRIOR** to the end time of 9:15 p.m.. I agree that if contacted to pick up my teen that I will come to the Library and take my teen home.

I assert that my teen is between the ages of 11 and 18. I agree not to hold the Camdenton Library responsible for any accidents or mishaps which may involve my teen. If my teen should become seriously ill or injured, I authorize the Camden County Library District to arrange for any emergency medical care needed.

The Camdenton Library is **NOT** responsible for supplying NERF equipment, NERF guns or NERF ammo, for the players. Each participant **MUST** have their name or initials on their property.

Rules of NERF Battle

- Eye protection is a **MUST** (Goggles will be supplied)
- Stay within the public areas of the library.
- **NO** shooting your opponent within 10 feet of each other
- **NO** shooting computer monitors
- **NO** shooting the ceiling fans in the main part of the library
- **NO** drinking, climbing, or playing in the fountain
- **NO** climbing the shelving units
- **NO** standing on top of the furniture; you may crawl underneath the furniture
- **NO** open toed shoes
- **NO** hitting, pinching, biting, kicking, pushing; if you can't do it at school, you can't do it here
- **NO** pushing on the shelving units
- Be sure to put your name on your gun and your ammunition beforehand; we aren't responsible for lost or misplaced NERF guns or bullets
- Long pants are required
- Follow the instructions of the Library Staff and Volunteers
